

## **North Beacon Hill Council Meeting Minutes**

Tuesday, March 6, 2012

**7:00 PM**, Beacon Hill Library Community Room

### **Beacon Bikes.**

Nolan Rundquist, SDOT City Arborist, presented information about the Re-Leaf program. The program is providing tree planting in Beacon Hill along the new Greenway and other areas needing trees. Trees are being planted in parking strips, which will be maintained by SDOT. Residents can opt out by calling numbers on door hangers. Trees are also being offered to be planted on the property of residents that want trees.

### **Triangle Park Residents.**

A group of three residents and business owners (Gary, Walter, and Red) who live and own businesses near the proposed "Mighty Oak" business presented their concerns with the proposed business. They are concerned that the proposal may be for a "tavern" business, with late hours, loud activities in the alley adjacent to residents, and other negative factors associated with a tavern, like the former Beacon Pub. Two of the owners of the Mighty Oak were in attendance and described the proposed business model, which is that of a family friendly restaurant with a small enclosed lounge. The proposed liquor license is for both beer and spirits. The owners will be living in the apartment connected to the business.

### **Friends of Lewis Park.**

Dee Dunbar presented news about Lewis Park. Dee is requesting volunteer commitments for a Small and Simple Grant application for \$20,000. The Seattle Parks Foundation is going to be fiscal sponsor for Friends of Lewis Park. A tour of the Mountains to Sound Trail and Lewis Park is scheduled for April 11.

### **Jefferson Park Clubhouse.**

The clubhouse did not get landmark status, but the vote was tied. Roger Pence is organizing a separate meeting for those interested in the clubhouse issue.
